PERMISSION FOR DIAGNOSTIC RECORDS FOR ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT

Before orthodontic treatment can begin, the following diagnostic records are taken for review and/or submission to your insurance company if applicable for treatment approval. If treatment is not approved for benefit payment by your insurance company or you need these records for a second opinion, there will be a separate fee for these records.

Panoramic X-Ray: This X-ray shows all primary and permanent teeth, erupted and non-erupted, along with their root structure.

Cephalometric X-Ray: This X-ray shows the bone structure along with the dentition. Detailed systems of the measurements are taken from this x-ray so Dr. Saleh can tailor the treatment for each patient.

Study Models or Scan Models: The dentition is scanned and/or impressions are taken so Dr. Saleh can determine the occlusion (how the teeth fit together). This is normally done when a patient begins treatment.

Facial Photographs: These photographs give an in-depth look at the face from a frontal and profile perspective to see if the face is symmetrical in development.

Intra-oral Photographs: These photographs give an in-depth look at the teeth and the condition of the gum tissue.

This appointment will take approximately thirty (30) minutes. The fee for this procedure is covered by Medicaid whether treatment is approved for payment or not. Our office will notify you of Medicaid's decision usually within two (2) weeks from the date of the records submission.
